How we think about structured co-investment alongside our own positions.

INSTITUTIONAL — CO-INVESTMENT FRAMEWORK

Structured capital placed alongside our own positions

Alongside our direct venture, private equity, and real estate activity, we hold a smaller set of structured co-investment positions — additional capital placed alongside a private equity or venture holding, often with different terms, timing, or seniority. This document sets out how we think about that activity.

Why co-investment

Structured co-investment lets us diversify away from listed-market cycles, access relationship-driven opportunities, and remain patient with capital that does not need daily liquidity — consistent with how we approach alternative investments more broadly.

How we evaluate a co-investment

- **Structural clarity** — whether rights, obligations, and ownership are clearly documented and understood.
- **Fit alongside existing holdings** — whether the position complements our venture, private equity, and real estate activity rather than duplicating it.
- **Time horizon** — whether the position suits patient capital not seeking a near-term exit.
- **Counterparty quality** — the standing of the other parties involved.
- **Concentration** — how the position sits relative to the rest of the portfolio.

Governance

As with every commitment we make, co-investment positions are assessed under our own governance and held as principal. We do not operate this activity as a pooled fund, and we do not offer it as a standardised product to external investors.

This document describes our general approach to co-investment. It does not disclose any specific holding, partner, or transaction.
