Investment Criteria

What we look for across Venture Capital, Development Capital, and Private Equity.

INSTITUTIONAL — INVESTMENT CRITERIA

What we look for, and what we do not

Every application we receive is assessed against the same published criteria, regardless of size. This document sets out the situations we typically consider across Venture Capital, Development Capital, and Private Equity, and the situations that fall outside our remit.

Venture Capital — situations we consider

- Early-stage teams with a working product or a credible path to one, raising their first meaningful round of outside capital.
- Growth-stage companies that have found early traction and need capital to scale the team, the product, or the go-to-market.
- Follow-on rounds alongside an existing capital structure, where we are introduced to a company already moving forward.

Development Capital — situations we consider

- A profitable regional business ready to expand nationally, without wanting to sell a controlling stake to fund the rollout.
- A manufacturer that needs new equipment or additional capacity to take on larger orders.
- A services business seeking to fund the acquisition of a smaller competitor.
- A company with a proven, repeatable model that needs working capital to scale faster than cash flow alone allows.

Private Equity — what disqualifies a situation

- The company cannot demonstrate clear, verifiable legal standing in its jurisdiction.
- The transaction would require us to provide regulated financial advice or manage funds on behalf of a third party.
- Ownership, existing debt, or the current capital structure cannot be clarified to our satisfaction.

Indicative funding ranges

Applications are reviewed across the following indicative amount ranges. These are ranges only, not commitments or offers of funding at any level.

Range
Under £100,000
£100,000 – £500,000
£500,000 – £2,000,000
£2,000,000 – £10,000,000
Over £10,000,000

Every application is reviewed against these published criteria and our internal governance process. Review takes time; submission alone does not create any right to funding, a response within a given period, or a commitment of any kind. Applications are submitted through the Apply For Funding process on our website.
